Mr. Khan Sereyvuthy graduated from the Royal University of Law and Economics (RULE) in 2008, with a Master of laws in Private laws and Bachelor of Law in 1997 from the Faculty of Law and Economics in Phnom Penh and was admitted to practice as attorney at law. Mr. Sereyvuthy took part in the training courses on Commercial Arbitration Law, practice and skills by the Experts from the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators (Siarb) and International Finance Corporation (IFC) and received the Certificate of intermediate course on the Commercial Arbitration Skills issued by the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators. Mr. Sereyvuthy is the first commercial arbitrator admitted to the National Commercial Arbitration Center (NCAC).

His client was released by the Tribunal Court of ECCC.

Mr. Sereyvuthy was the Director of Training and the co-trainer with the Canadian lawyers on the international business transactions and contracts, bankruptcy law and commercial arbitration law at the Lawyer Training Center (LTC) of the Bar Association of the Kingdom of Cambodia.

Mr. Sereyvuthy worked with other international organizations such as UNHCR, UNTAC, American Bar Association, US Embassy in Phnom Penh, the US Funded Long Term International Election Observation Groups.
